

## KRONES Security Advisory “Deprecation of Microsoft Silverlight” (KSA-2021-1)

On October 12, 2021, Microsoft plans to terminate security support for Silverlight completely. Due to this, Krones recommends uninstalling Silverlight on the affected products in advance.

**Timely action is recommended as Microsoft likely won't publish security updates for newly-discovered security vulnerabilities in Silverlight after October 2021.**

### Affected products and services

The following table lists affected products or services, and specific remediation. Krones recommends implementing the suggested remediation measures.
